Project Overview

Our Streets MN is seeking a Research Assistant to support the *Re-Connecting the Twin Cities Oral History Project 2025*. This project will document oral histories of residents along St. Paul's I-94 corridor, focusing on their experiences during and after the interstate's construction through the present day.

The Research Assistant will work as a contractor for 100 hours between March and November 2025 at \$25/hour.

Scope of Work

The Research Assistant will:

- 1. Assist in scheduling individual and group interviews in collaboration with Our Streets staff.
- 2. Coordinate logistics with the filmmaker to ensure smooth operations during filming.
- 3. Proof and edit transcriptions using otter.ai, ensuring accuracy for archival purposes.
- 4. Support research tasks, including identifying historical resources in online databases.
- 5. Communicate effectively with project team members to ensure timely task completion.

Minimum Qualifications

- Proficiency in word processors and Google Drive applications.
- Basic knowledge of audio processing tools.
- Attention to detail and ability to proof and edit transcriptions.
- Good communication skills for scheduling and coordinating interviews.
- Reliable computer and internet access.

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience with historical research methods and familiarity with oral history techniques.
- Copy-editing and/or transcribing experience.
- Familiarity with neighborhoods along the I-94 corridor in St. Paul.

- 1. Cover Letter: Highlight relevant experience and interest in the project.
- 2. **Resume or CV:** Emphasize transcription, copy writing, research, and scheduling experience.

3. **References:** Provide two professional references.

Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be scored based on the following criteria (100 points total):

- 1. **Relevant Experience (50 points):** Demonstrated success in transcription, scheduling, and research tasks.
- 2. Attention to Detail (30 points): Examples of work that showcase proofreading and editing skills.
- 3. Local Knowledge (10 points): Familiarity with project neighborhoods.
- 4. **Communication Skills (10 points):** Clear and effective communication as evidenced in the cover letter and references.
